PARCS manages payment and access to public parking garages operated by DOTI. This is a replacement system for the outdated equipment currently in use. DPAC garage will be installed first, followed by Denver Justice Center Garage, Webb Garage, 303 Garage, Judges Garage and the Denver Cultural Center Garage. Installations will happen one at a time over the course of five years.

The updated equiptment will allow DOTI to manage the parking garages more efficiently (operationally and cost), cut back on staffing needs due to enhancements at entrances/exits, ensure we can operate to the fullest abilility for large events (DPAC and Cultural Center Garges) that allows us to maximize user experiences.
