### **Code Overview**

#### Summary of Applicable Ordinances

• Denver Zoning Code

Structures in zone OS-A shall be determined by City Council per D.R.M.C., Chapter 39 (Parks and Recreation)

• Chapter 39; Denver Revised Municipal Code (D.R.M.C.)

Buildings in city parks with footprints over 3,000 SF or over 35 FT in height must be approved as part of a Park Building Plan by City Council

#### Park Building Plan (PBP) Requirements

- Indicate adjacent existing structures and open spaces
- Locate proposed buildings (or additions) in excess of 3,000 SF or over 35 FT in height
- Identify maximum SF of building footprint (or addition)
- Identify maximum height of building (or addition)
- Provide notification to Registered Neighborhood
  Organizations (RNOs)
- City Council Public Hearing



# **Community Engagement Overview**

#### Summary of the Outreach Process

- An extensive community engagement plan is developed and implemented
- Feedback is received at various touchpoints and incorporated into the project as the design progresses
- The engagement process culminates with the submission and approval of the Park Building Plan Notification of submission to RNOs Public Hearing
- DPR will continue to provide project updates until construction completion and grand opening







#### **Project Details**


- 16,175 SF addition to GVR Recreation Center

#### **Aquatic Amenities**

- 4 lane 25-yard lap pool with 9' deep end
- Leisure pool with open water and zero depth entry
- Aquatic play features for all ages and stages

- Swimming lessons and lifeguard training
- Aqua aerobics, water walking
- Lap swimming



May 24, 2021 - Final Reading






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
