Department of Transportation and Infrastructure (DOTI) On-call Smart City Services Contract DOTI is seeking to establish a group of uniquely qualified On-call firms to respond to proposal requests for the execution of Connect Vehicle (CV) and Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) grant funded, and agency sponsored programs.

Purpose and Use of Agreements:

The goal is to award multiple On-call contracts and provide DOTI and other city agencies the ability to utilize specific support services from a variety of niche consultant teams. This will provide program managers ability to develop support teams for grant funded programs such as Advanced Transportation and Congestion Management Technologies (ATCMTD) and Regional Transportation Program (RTO) projects.

These professional services are in support of improvements that may include but are not limited to: Connect Pedestrian programs, Connected Fleet programs, Fiber Network communications support, Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) and support of the cities Enterprise Data Management (EDM).

Procurement:

Forty-Two (42) firms were selected based on qualification submittals which were reviewed and scored. Of those DOTI has identified thirteen (13) firms to move forward in support of existing programs. All thirteen (13) firms have been processed and have existing On-call contracts in place

Contracts Description:

Each contract has a three (3) year term, a capacity of \$3 million. These firms include:
