6 7 9 10 11	For an ordinance establishing a new fund in the General Government Special Revenue Fund Series for the "American Rescue Plan Act" program and approving and providing for the execution of a proposed Grant Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the United States of America Department of Treasury for the "Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery" program and the funding therefor.		
13	WHEREAS, the President signed the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) on March		
14	11, 2021; and		
15	WHEREAS, allowable uses of the ARPA's aid to local governments include providing		
16	government services to the extent of lost revenue, supporting immediate economic stabilization for		
17	households and businesses, supporting urgent COVID-19 response efforts, and addressing		
18	systemic public health and economic challenges that have contributed to the inequal impact of the		
19	pandemic; and		
20	WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver received a grant agreement from the Treasury		
21	Department on May 10 th , 2021 concerning the use of the ARPA dollars, thereby rendering these		
22	funds "grants in aid," per Section 20-52 of the Denver Revised Municipal Code (DRMC); and		
23	WHEREAS, per Section 20-52 of the DRMC, custodial funds do not require appropriation;		
24	however, because the ARPA custodial funds are dedicated in part to restoration of what would		
25	otherwise have been appropriated services, City Council shall approve the spending distributions		
26	for ARPA-authorized categories in the ARPA Fund; and		
27	WHEREAS, the Department of Finance wishes to establish a new Special Revenue Fund to		
28	receive, administer, and report spending of the ARPA dollars; and		
29	WHEREAS, the United States Treasury Department will disburse the first 50 percent of the		
30	full \$308,048,870 allocation, or \$154,024,435, upon submission of the signed grant agreement and		
31	committed to distributing the remaining 50 percent one year from that date; and		
32	WHEREAS, pending community input and further review of City agency and department		
33	requests by the Administration and City Council, spending approvals by City Council will be		
34	authorized through amendments to this Ordinance;		
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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

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Section 1. A new fund is hereby established in the General Government Special Revenue Fund
Series, the "American Rescue Plan Act" Fund, Accounting No. 11011, for the purpose of accounting
for the receipt and expenditure of Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund grant program dollars.

8 **Section 2.** Program expenditures are hereby authorized for the "American Rescue Plan Act" 9 Fund, Accounting No. 11011, in the amount not to exceed the total of deposits described in Section 10 1 of this ordinance. Allowable expenditures include services and supplies, personnel services, 11 capital equipment, transfers to capital project funds, or other program costs that the Department of 12 Treasury deems allowable under the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021. All spending shall be 13 authorized by City Council through approved allocations in the "American Rescue Plan Act" Fund. 14 The expending authorities in the Fund are the agencies or departments administering the approved 15 program dollars. This Fund is sponsor-based and non-lapsing.

Section 3. The proposed Grant Agreement, under CFDA 21.019, between the City and County
 of Denver and the United States Department of Treasury for the "Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery
 Fund" program, which is identified as OMB Number 1505-0271, a copy of which is duly filed with the
 City Clerk, Filing No. 202158783, be and hereby is approved in all respects.

Section 4. The payments made by the United States Department of Treasury to the City pursuant to and under the Grant Agreement shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Revenue Fund No. 11000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

Section 5. That it be and is hereby found and determined that the budget summary of saidprogram is as follows:

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28 The foregoing budget summary reflects the total Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund grant 29 agreement. City Council shall authorize spending for ARPA-approved categories through amendments to this Ordinance. Expenditures of said funds are authorized from March 3, 2021 to
 December 31, 2026.

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Section 6. The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized
and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary
to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
