

## Department of Public Health & Environment Grant Agreement Programming Executive Summary

## **Maternal Child Health**

This program will expand the current Maternal Child Health focus in DDPHE and is comprised of three sections of work: 1) Access to Supports (clinical care coordination for new and expectant mothers and families), Economic Mobility (specialized co-enrollment in social service benefit programs at Denver Health community clinics and through a variety of community based partners), Social Emotional Wellbeing (Youth and Perinatal Mental Health services and support groups for new and expectant mothers and their families. The primary goal of all this work is to reduce disparities in infant mortality rates and improve overall quality of life for new and expectant mothers and their families. There is an explicit focus on health disparities by different racial, ethnic and economic groups that this funding aims to close.
