



## BACKGROUND



The COVID-19 pandemic caused significant disruption to air travel and precipitous drops in concession sales at DEN. Only 39 of 136 concessions remained open throughout the pandemic. This occurred between March 16, 2020 and February 1, 2021. To assist our concessionaire partners in this unprecedented time, DEN's 2020 COVID-19 relief policy provided for the following:

- Percentage of sales as rent instead of the minimum annual guarantee
- Suspension of Joint Marketing Fund contributions, mid-term refurbishments and PVC program
- Ability to adjust operating hours and close based on business need and activity
- Ability to terminate contract without penalty
- Offer of first right of refusal for layoffs and furloughed employees

## IMPORTANCE OF LEASE EXTENSIONS



On March 18, 2021, the Denver Concessionaires Association (DCA) sent the Mayor's Economic Relief & Recovery Council (ERRC) a letter requesting lease extensions to concession agreements. Among other things, the DCA cited these factors in support of their request for extensions:

- Once the concessionaires' businesses were demobilized, it was difficult to re-start.
- Difficulty in working with banking partners to cover expenses as revenues were falling.
- Lease extensions offer certainty of repayment to the concessionaires' banking partners and provide the freedom to expand investment in their employees.
- The ability for concessionaires to restructure debt was difficult, if not impossible, without lease extensions.

Ultimately, the ERRC recommended that the lease agreements be extended for 3 years.

## HISTORY OF EXTENSIONS & SIMILAR OFFERINGS



- DEN has a history of offering these types of extensions. For example, 10-year
  extensions were granted to concessionaires following the economic impacts of
  September 11th.
- Additionally, in light of the impact of COVID-19 on airport concessionaires, over 10
   other large airports have offered term extensions. The extensions range from 1-3
   years and are similar in that they include holdover and term-remaining agreements.
- Our airport counterparts in Phoenix found the 3-year extensions were specifically helpful in assisting ACDBE operators with refinancing loans.

## COVID-19 CONCESSION EXTENSIONS OVERVIEW



The Amendment request to amend 83 concession agreements listed in "Exhibit A" will help support concessionaires and their workforces, and ensure that essential goods and services will remain available to passengers and employees at DEN. Each agreement in Exhibit A will be extended by three (3) years from the agreement expiration date. No other contract terms will change.

The eight additional concession agreements were not complete at this time and will be brought forward later.

## **DEN'S EXPECTATIONS**



Concessionaires must remain in good standing to maintain the 3-year extension, including:

- Strict compliance with ACDBE regulations and related City investigations and orders;
- Refurbishment, maintenance, and repairs of the concession premises as needed or otherwise directed by the City to maintain a first-class concession during the extension;
- Work with City if needed to promptly update or amend aging contracts that have outdated or missing City or federally required provisions; and
- Good faith efforts to support the wellbeing of current and prior employees, including rights to first refusal to laid off and furloughed personnel for any open employment positions for which they are qualified.

## DEN'S EXPECTATIONS CONTINUED



The City may terminate a concession that was previously on holdover tenancy if the premises must be used for other purposes, including but not limited to a scheduled development in the Great Hall. All other terms and conditions of individual concession agreements will remain in full force and effect.
