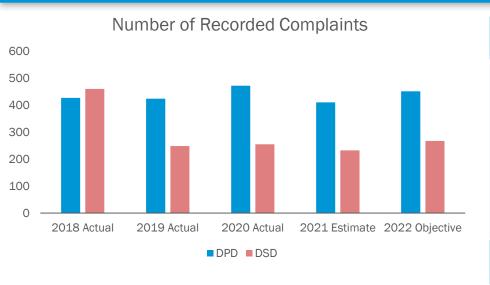


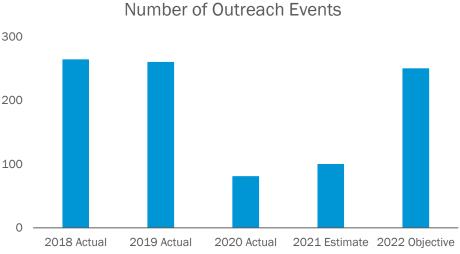
# OIM-Focused YOY General Fund Budget and FTEs

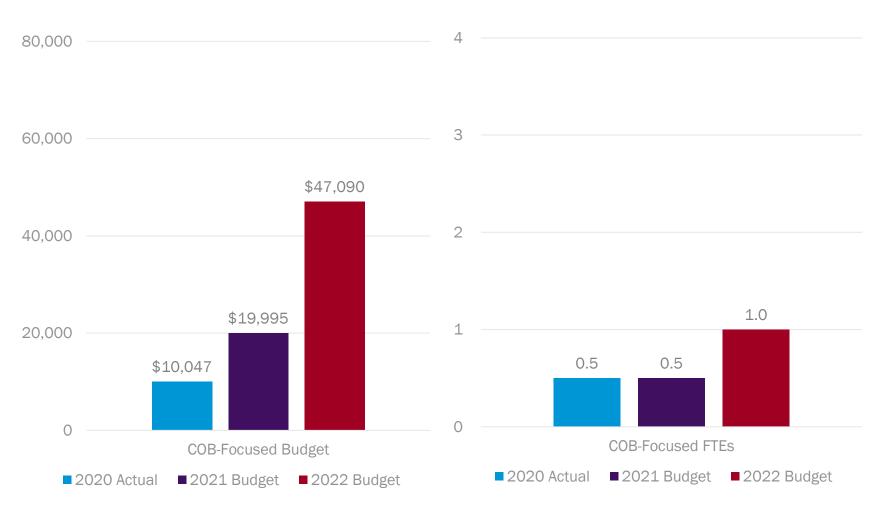
- Budget Priority 1 Focus on evolving our community engagement and customer service to support residents navigating City services, resources and accessibility including language access.

## Citizen Oversight Board Expansions

Personnel Expenditures	FTE	Services & Supplies
\$62,100	0.5 - Unlimited	\$27,100

Build capacity and professionalize the work of the COB in light of community demand for increased oversight

- An increase in personnel services to convert the single COB staff position from part- to full-time
  - This increase happened mid-year 2021 and was funded from a transfer out of the Department of Safety appropriation
  - The full-time position is budgeted under the Office of the Independent Monitor for 2022
- An increase in services and supplies for the Citizen Oversight Board for
  - Consulting for research, data analysis, board retreat/orientation, and graphic design
  - Stipends for two new COB positions
  - Increased resources for communication and community outreach (e.g., PSA video, MailChimp, brochures, and other outreach materials)
