That effective April 1, 2021, Chapter 18, Article IV, Section 18-102,, D.R.M.C. shall 14 15 be amended by deleting the language stricken and adding the language underlined, to read as follows: 16 17 Sec. 18-102. - Longevity pay. 18 19 (a) For the period of January 1, 2008 through December 21, 2008, longevity pay for deputy sheriff majors, deputy sheriff division chiefs, and the undersheriff hired on or 20 21 after January 1, 1996, shall be paid when the person reaches his or her ninth 22 anniversary date of employment in a deputy sheriff classification. The rate shall be 23 four dollars (\$4.00) per month for each year of service up to twenty-five (25) years. No employee shall receive longevity compensation in excess of one hundred dollars 24 25 (\$100.00) per month or one thousand two hundred dollars (\$1,200.00) per year. 26 27 (b) For the period of January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2008, longevity pay for deputy sheriff majors, deputy sheriff division chiefs, and the undersheriff hired on or 28 29 before December 31, 1995, shall be paid when the person reaches his or her fifth anniversary date of employment in a deputy sheriff classification. The rate shall be 30 seven dollars (\$7.00) per month for each year of service up to twenty-five (25) years. 31 No employee shall receive longevity compensation in excess of one hundred seventy-32 five dollars (\$175.00) per month or two thousand one hundred dollars (\$2,100.00) per 33 34 year. 35 (c)(a) Effective January 1, 2009, deputy sheriff majors, deputy sheriff division chiefs, and the 36 undersheriff, upon reaching their fifth anniversary date of employment, shall be paid 37 longevity pay at the rate of seven dollars (\$7.00) per month for each year of service 38 except that no employee shall receive longevity compensation in excess of one 39 40 hundred seventy-five dollars (\$175.00) per month or two thousand one hundred dollars (\$2,100.00) per year. Notwithstanding the above, effective April 1, 2021 41 42 through December 31, 2021, there will be no longevity pay pursuant to this section paid to deputy sheriff majors, deputy sheriff division chiefs, or the 43 sheriff. 44

Section 2. That effective January 1, 2021, Chapter 18, Article IV, Section 18-106, D.R.M.C. shall be amended by deleting the language stricken and adding the language underlined, to read as follows:

Sec. 18-106. – Designation of holidays.

Deputy sheriff majors, deputy sheriff division chiefs, and the undersheriff shall receive eight (8) hours of holiday leave on the following days:

- (1) New Year's Day (January 1);
- (2) Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day (third Monday in January);
- (3) Presidents' Day (third Monday in February);
- (4) Cesar Chavez Day (last Monday in March);
- (5) Memorial Day (last Monday in May);
- (6) Independence Day (July 4);
- (7) Labor Day (first Monday in September);
- (8) Veteran's Day (November 11);
- (9) Thanksgiving Day (fourth Thursday in November);
- (10) Christmas Day (December 25);
- (11) Personal holiday (on a date chosen by the employee under procedures approved by the undersheriff, or in the case of the undersheriff, the manager of safety).

Notwithstanding the above, the following designated holidays will not be recognized in 2021 by deputy sheriff majors, deputy sheriff division chiefs, or the sheriff: Cesar Chavez day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Veteran's Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.

Section 3. That effective January 1, 2021, Chapter 18, Article IV, Section 18-110, D.R.M.C. shall be amended by deleting the language stricken and adding the language underlined, to read as follows:

31 Sec. 1

Sec. 18-110. – Uniform maintenance.

An annual allowance shall be paid to deputy sheriff majors, deputy sheriff division chiefs, and the sheriff for the maintenance of uniforms in the amount of six hundred fifty dollars (\$650.00). This payment shall be made at the end of each calendar year. Upon separation other than for cause, this payment shall be prorated for the number of months served during the calendar year. Notwithstanding the above, there will be no annual uniform allowance paid in 2021 to deputy sheriff majors, deputy sheriff division chiefs, or the sheriff.

Section 4. That effective January 1, 2021, Chapter 22, Article II, Division 3, Section 22-35, D.R.M.C. shall be amended by deleting the language stricken and adding the language underlined, to read as follows:

Sec. 22-35. - Salaries and grades of chief, deputy chief and division chiefs of the fire department.
