

CdeBaca Amendment to the Mayor's Proposed 2022 Budget 21-1337

Madam President: I move that the Mayor's Proposed 2022 Budget be amended in the following particulars:

- 1. On page 658, in the line titled "Safety Management Expenditures by Type Total" (Fund 3501000) reduce the amount in the 2022 Recommended column by \$5,000,000.
- 2. On page 482, in the line titled "Department of Housing Stability Expenditures by Type Total" (Fund 0144000) increase the amount in the 2022 Recommended column by \$5,000,000 from \$33,765,967 to \$38,765,967 to renovate a full-service mental health and substance abuse treatment facility within the old PADF.
- 3. Make other appropriate adjustments to comments, tables, schedules, and figures in the Mayor's Proposed 2022 Budget as may be required to reflect the actions in this amendment.

Explanation: One of the biggest gaps in services that we have City-wide is longer-term treatment of mental health and substance abuse issues. These conditions impact a substantial chunk of our unhoused population and our jail population. If we used housing recovery dollars to create a facility that was somewhere between permanent supportive housing, a hospital and treatment program then we could ultimately reduce our jail bed population and our unhoused population.
