

## CdeBaca Amendment to the Mayor's Proposed 2022 Budget 21-1344

Madam President: I move that the Mayor's Proposed 2022 Budget be amended in the following particulars:

- 1. On page 658, in the line titled "Safety Management Expenditures by Type Total" (Fund 3501000) reduce the amount in the 2022 Recommended column by \$50,000.
- 2. On page 454, in the line titled "Public Health and Wellness" (Fund 6501000) increase the amount in the 2022 Recommended column by \$50,000 from \$0 to \$50,000 to provide 24- hour lockers for experiencing homelessness.
- 3. Make other appropriate adjustments to comments, tables, schedules, and figures in the Mayor's Proposed 2022 Budget as may be required to reflect the actions in this amendment.

**Explanation:** Many homeless people work or access services and need a place to store their belongings rather than leaving them outdoors unattended or foregoing work to stay with their belongings. 24-hour accessible lockers are needed for accessing resources without worrying about where to store belongings. The unit cost for lockers is \$100 per 1 ft by 1 ft by 4 ft locker. This would also address complaints people have had about sweeps and storage of items being inaccessible. Sweeps could then provide the option/resource of a locker.
