

CdeBaca Amendment to the Mayor's Proposed 2022 Budget 21-1345

Madam President: I move that the Mayor's Proposed 2022 Budget be amended in the following particulars:

- 1. On page 392, in the line titled "Downtown Administration" (Fund 0111000) reduce the amount in the 2022 Recommended column by \$200,000.
- 2. On page 615, in the line titled "Parks and Recreation Expenditure by Type Total" (Fund 7010000) increase the amount in the 2022 Recommended column by \$200,000 from \$4,887,189 to \$5,087,189 to provide Denver Day Works Expansion-Employment of homeless workers to clean and maintain encampments and surrounding areas.
- 3. Make other appropriate adjustments to comments, tables, schedules, and figures in the Mayor's Proposed 2022 Budget as may be required to reflect the actions in this amendment.

Explanation: Homeless rights advocates have been coordinating street clean-up in exchange for meals and other assistance. By funding this self-efficacy model, the City would build trust and develop partnerships to work toward common goals including employment and trash abatement as well as improving the safety of allegedly dangerous/flammable/rodent-infested encampments.
