#### History and Location

- Old Denver Post printing site, now development called Fox Park.
  - +/- 41 acre site.
- Original Service Plans approved in March of 2016 (CB16-0079) with a previous property owner.
  - Based on an investment of ~\$11.8M in public infrastructure.
- Current property owner's development plan necessitates a change to the Districts' Service Plans.
  - Inclusion area remains the same.

### Metropolitan District Request

- First Amended and Restated Service Plans for West Globeville MD No. 1 and West Globeville MD No. 2.
  - MD #1 will encompass commercial properties;
  - MD#2 will encompass residential properties
- Using Model Service Plan
- Service Plans' financial plans indicate that proposed development includes:
  - Apartments, Hotels, Office, and Retail uses
- Public Improvements consist of:
  - Streets, water, sanitary and storm sewer, parks, parking garage
  - Estimated total cost of public improvements of \$340M+



## Amendment: Key Highlights

- Disclosure to land purchases (concept from our new draft model service plan).
- Proposed Mill Levy cap:
  - Regional mill of 5.000 mills.
  - Mill levy caps:
    - Aggregate Mill Max = 50.000 mills
    - 0&M Mill Cap= 10.000 mills
- 40 year max Debt Mill Imposition Term





- Projected debt issuance of ~\$150M from the Districts to support the public improvements.
  - Assumes only 30 debt mills pledged + 1% PIF
  - Anticipated to be issued in multiple series to pay for construction costs related to public improvements, including public garages.
  - Issuances anticipated to align with construction phasing starting in 2022; expected completion in 2030
