Central Park III Apartments, a 127-unit affording housing development, is located at the northwest corner of Central Park Blvd. and E. 35<sup>th</sup> Ave. in the Central Park neighborhood in a transit-oriented development site just one block from the Central Park light rail station, new Sprouts grocery, employment centers, commercial services, and retail, highly rated schools, and healthy living amenities. Central Park III Apartments will provide a variety of apartments suitable for households of varying sizes including family and single households. Of the 127 units, 11 will be restricted at 30% AMI, 18 at 40% AMI, 82 at 50% AMI and 16 at 60% AMI. The project has a range of unit sizes, comprised of 12 studios, 33 one-bedrooms, 76 two-bedrooms, and 6 three-bedrooms. As with all of NDHC LIHTC developments in Central Park, NDHC will provide an on-site case manager, in collaboration with service providers, to implement healthy living and wellness programs such as self-development education, educational youth programs, after-school tutoring, nutrition classes, healthy cooking, gardening classes, access to food banks, job training, resume development, mental health services and financial literacy classes. The loan review committee conditionally approved a \$1,985,000 cash-flow loan for this development, which has a total development cost of roughly \$27,000,000.
