| This resolution seeks approval to finance the purchase of energy conservation measure implementation equipmer ("Equipment") via a capital equipment lease agreement on behalf of Department of General Services ("GS"). The Equipment provides for improvements that will result in energy conservation throughout various City facilities. The amount of the Equipment to be purchased via the capital lease purchase transaction is \$14,811,869.22. JP Morgan Chas Bank, N.A. ("JPM"), selected via a competitive bid process, will serve as the lessor. The proposed leasing structure will consist of two components: a 5-year component consisting of equipment with a designated 5-year useful life and annual lease payments of approximately \$740,875.93 and a 15-year component of equipment with a designated 15-year useful life with annual lease payment of approximately \$854,031.94. The lease payments will be supported by the energy savings created by the equipment improvement and will be repaid from the Annual Capital Improvement Program, Utility Savings and Climate Protection Fund, subject to annual appropriation by City Council. The interest rate will be locked at 1.60% which translates to total interest cost of approximatel \$1,702,990. If Council approves this resolution, the City targets closing the week of December 13, 2021. This capital equipment lease purchase resolution request is being submitted in conjunction with the two equipment and service procurement contract requests submitted by General Services for delivery and installation of the Equipment by McKinstry Essention LLC and Ameresco, Inc. Approval of the equipment and services resolution requests will allow for the lease purchase of the Equipment through transaction with JPM. | | | | |

Executive Summary

A resolution to authorize the Manager of Finance to enter into a capital lease purchase transaction, on behalf of the Department of General Services to purchase Energy Conservation Measure Equipment via Energy Performance Contracting in a principal amount not to exceed \$15,000,000.

The Department of Finance is seeking approval finance the acquisition of Energy Conservation Equipment ("Equipment") to be procured from McKinstry Essention LLC and Ameresco, Inc, through a capital lease purchase transaction on behalf of the Department of General Services ("General Services"). The expected total cost of the Equipment to be lease purchased is \$14,811,869.22.

The proposed lease purchase structure will consist of a 15-year capital lease, broken into 5-year and 15-year components that aligns with the useful life of the equipment being financed, between the City and JPMorgan Chase Bank, N.A. ("JPM"), selected via a competitive bid process. The capital equipment lease will provide a 1.60% fixed interest rate, which translates to total interest cost for the City of approximately \$1,702,990 through the final term of the lease. The annual lease payments of approximately \$740,876 in years 2023-2027 and approximately \$854,032 in years 2028-2037 are subject to annual appropriation by City Council and will be supported by energy savings generated by the Equipment improvement and repaid from the Annual Capital Improvement Program, Utility Savings and Climate Protection Fund. The City may prepay the lease at par, without penalty, on any payment date after an initial 12 months.

This lease purchase agreement is part of a package that will consist of a total of four (4) resolutions, and it is requested that they be presented as a single project. The resolutions are:

- 1) The above Lease Purchase Agreement, which entails the capital lease purchase with JPM; total lease payments (if all appropriations are made) are approximately \$16,514,859 submitted by the Department of Finance on behalf of General Services.
- 2) Equipment and Services procurement contract with McKinstry Essention LLC, the vendor for the energy conservation equipment that includes improvements to five Fire Stations, five Police Facilities, City and County Building, Denver Crime Lab, Lindsey-Flanigan Courthouse, Elections Building, Van Cise-Simonet Detention Center, and others. This resolution will be submitted by General Services.
- 3) Equipment and Services procurement contract with Ameresco, Inc., the vendor for the energy conservation equipment that includes improvements to 15 recreation centers/buildings and seven libraries. This resolution will be submitted by General Services.
- 4) Purchase Order for McKinstry Essention LLC, the vendor for the energy conservation equipment that includes improvements to for the DPD Traffic Operations Center. This resolution will be submitted by General Services.
