Cathy Reynolds

- 1975 First woman elected to the City Council, a month earlier than the second, Cathy Donohue.
- Re-elected for a total of seven terms
- Longest continuous tenure of any council member – 28 years and two weeks
- Served alongside 38 different members during her tenure
- Elected by colleagues four times as president, eight times as pro-tem





Women serving on Denver City Council since 1975

- Since the election of the first two women members, a majority of members have been women
- From 1979 to present, 31 of the 56 people elected to council were women
- Prior to 1975, only one woman served; Elisa Palladino, appointed by Mayor Begole in 1935 to last four months of term of Eugene Veraldi, who resigned before the election



WOMAN JOINS COUNCIL Denver Mother of Three Is Named to City Post by Mayor. DENVER, March 1 (AP).—Mrs. Elisa A. Palladino, 50, mother of three grown children, was appointed yesterday by Mayor George Begole as Denver's first woman member of the City Council.

Mrs. Palladino, ardent Republican worker, will succeed Eugene Veraldi, who resigned.

"You can bet I won't neglect my cooking and sewing," Mrs. Palladino smiled.

Policy Initiatives

- One of the nation's first gay rights laws, 1990, leading in part to Colorado Amendment 2
- State and US Supreme Court battles led to striking Amendment 2 and upholding Denver's law
- Revision to Denver's most restrictive zoning regulation that prevented unmarried couples from living together in the most exclusive neighborhoods
- Successful drive for budget amendment to establish a mill levy for services for people with developmental disabilities
- Led the ban on assault-style firearms in Denver in 1989, receiving police protection while receiving numerous death threats; ordinance survived challenges both from the state legislature and in the courts
