22	Section 1. A new Fund is hereby established in the Economic Opportunity Special Revenue			
23	Fund Series, Accounting No. 17000, a "Denver Construction Careers Contribution" Fund,			
24	Accounting No. 17806, for the purpose of accounting for the receipt and expenditure of program			
25	dollars.			
26	Section 2. Monies received from contributions collected through optional opt-out charges			
27	applied to City-issued permits for Accounting No. 17806 shall be deposited into the Treasury of the			
28	City and credited to Special Revenue Fund No. 17000, which is set forth and described in Section			
29	20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.			
30	Section 3. Program expenditures are hereby authorized for the "Denver Construction Careers			
31	Contribution" Fund, Accounting No. 17806 to be expended by the Executive Director of the Denver

Economic Development and Opportunity. Allowable expenses include payments to City partners to
