12	Section 1. That article XI, division 1, of Chapter 24, D.R.M.C., shall be amended by deleting		
13	the language stricken and adding the language underlined, to read as follows:

16	<u>(f)</u>	Retail tobacco-focused business means a	any retail store operating as a tobacco
17	business, as defined in C.R.S. 25-14-203(18), and includes smoke shops and cigar shops, but		
18	does not include hookah tobacco retailers.		
19	<u>(fg</u>)	Retail tobacco store means a business of	any kind that sells, gives, delivers, or
20	furnishes tobacco products to a user or consumer.		
21	(g h)	Tobacco product means:	
22	(1)	Any product containing tobacco or nicotine	or that is made or derived from tobacco that
23	may be used to introduce tobacco or nicotine into the human body, including but not limited to,		
24	cigarettes, cigars, pipe tobacco, hookah tobacco, snuff, chewing tobacco, dipping tobacco, dissolvable		
25	tobacco products, and nicotine-enhanced products;		
26	(2)	Any electronic device that may be used to d	deliver nicotine to the person inhaling from the
27	device, including any solution, compound, or other substance containing nicotine to be used with the		

nicotine that may be used to introduce nicotine into the human body.

Excluded from this definition are any products specifically approved by the United States Food

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and Drug Administration for use in reducing, treating, or eliminating nicotine or tobacco dependence or for other medical purposes, when these products are being marketed and sold solely for such

approved purpose. 1 2 Sec. 24-402. - Sale of tobacco products to persons under twenty-one (21) years of age 3 prohibited. 4 5 It shall be unlawful for any person to sell, give, deliver or furnish any tobacco product to (a) anyone who has not reached twenty-one (21) years of age. 6 7 It shall be unlawful for any person to permit or allow the person's agent, servant, officer (b) 8 or employee to sell, give, deliver or furnish any tobacco product to anyone who has not reached 9 twenty-one (21) years of age. (c) It shall be unlawful for any retail tobacco-focused business to allow any person under the 10 age of twenty-one (21) on the licensed premises. Government-issued identification must be required 11 12 from all patrons before the patron is allowed access into the licensed premises. 13 Any person who sells or offers to sell tobacco products shall display the warning sign(s) (ed) 14 required by C.R.S. § 44-7-103, as amended. 15 Section 2.
