19	WHEREAS, Companion Ordinance 21-1212 establishes the Climate Protection Capital

21	transfers from the Climate Protection Fund and administer capital projects that support climate

23	WHEREAS, the City desires to transfer funds from Climate Protection SRF to the Climate
