Consent Items

Grants a revocable permit, subject to certain terms and conditions, to Denver Bike Sharing, their successors and assigns, to encroach into the right of way with a bike docking station at 3669 Blake Street in Council District 9.

Council Resolution 19-0679 was approved by consent

Approves an intergovernmental agreement with the Regional Transportation District (RTD) for \$1,835,299 and for five years for RTD to fund up to four Denver Human Services Eligibility Technician II's, who will provide eligibility determination and enrollment into RTD's LiVE Program, a fare discount program for low-income individuals, citywide (SOCSV-201950941).

19-0685 Approves the purchase of capital equipment from the Parks, Trails, and Open Space Special Revenue Fund and from the Denver Arts and Venues Special Revenue Fund.

Amends the Denver Revised Municipal Code (DRMC) to establish a new capital improvement fund series 36000 named the Parks, Trails, and Open Space fund, for the purpose of planning, design, and construction of capital improvements for parks, trails, and open space projects, including land acquisition.

19-0687 Establishes three new capital improvement projects funds (36015, 36045,
