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Consent Items

20-0677

Establishes the "Climate State Grants Fund," a new Fund in the General Government Special Revenue Fund Series and approves a grant agreement with The State of Colorado Department of Local Affairs for \$1,000,000 and through 6-30-23 for the construction of community solar gardens hosted across public parking lots, rooftops, and other land parcels owned by the City, citywide (CASR-202055160-00).

Council Bill 20-0677 was approved by consent

20-0679

Approves a grant agreement with the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment for \$5,192,109.73 of State funds and through 12-19-22 to provide reimbursement for the City's COVID-19 response including critical containment activities such as disease surveillance, case investigation, contact tracing, and testing, citywide (ENVHL-202055225-00).
