#### **Action Items**

21-1190 Amends a contract with the Colorado Coalition for the Homeless by adding \$9,041,667 for a new total of \$10,241,667 for housing placement and treatment services for adults experiencing chronic homelessness, citywide. No change to contract duration (HOST- 202159074-01).

#### **Consent Items**

21-1175 Approves an intergovernmental agreement with School District Number One (Denver Public Schools Department of Culturally Sustaining Curriculum and Instruction) for \$600,000 and through 7-31-23 to implement Phase II of the Social, Emotional, Academic, and Learning Initiative at six school sites (MOEAI-202160143).

21-1176 Amends a contract with CitySpan by adding \$122,500 for a new total of \$563,500 to add maintenance fees for the DAAconnect Management Information System to support youth-serving organizations to more efficiently track and report on child and youth outcomes.
