## Type and Scope of services to be performed:

The purpose of the contract is to establish an agreement and scope of services between the Department of Housing Stability ("HOST") and Pennrose, LLC (the "Contractor"). This contract will provide for a supportive housing services reserve for 56 chronically homeless transition-aged youth in Denver at 2700 Wewatta.

HOST is requesting \$1,260,000.00 for supportive services funding in a grant, which includes \$225,000 from a partnership with Denver Human Services. The use of the funds as detailed in an annual report will be reviewed to verify that the funds are used for eligible costs as defined in 24 C.F.R. Sec. 578.53 and will be reviewed for consistency with the approved budget. The total amount will be set-aside in a City reserve fund.

#### Scope of work:

#### **Roles and Responsibilities for both parties:**

- Contractor will deliver supportive housing for 56 eligible participants.
- Contractor will provide supportive services to eligible participants to assist such individuals or households with maintaining housing.
- City will provide timely review and response to received reports.
- City will provide timely response to draws for funding.

#### **Supportive Housing Requirements:**

<u>Supportive Housing Requirements:</u> All 56 units in the subject property will be supportive housing units. Furthermore, provision of supportive services is expected for all the 56 supportive housing units. At all times, a minimum of 50% of all tenants residing in the supportive housing units must be sourced through OneHome, the regional coordinated entry system maintained by the City and County of Denver. Of the remaining units, 10 units will be referred through the Denver Chafee Program (Denver Human Services). Participants referred through the Denver Chafee Program are eligible for housing and services. Pennrose, LLC shall help facilitate the application process after a youth has been recommended by the Denver Chafee Independent Living Program Manager (ILPM). <u>Contractor Requirements:</u>

- Outcomes and HMIS Reporting: Contractor must report all necessary data and information in the Homeless Management Information System ("HMIS").
- Commitment to Quality: The Contractor is required to commit to the provision of high-quality supportive housing.
- Supportive Services Standards: Contractor must have a staff-to-client ratio of no less than one (1) staff person to every fifteen (15) supportive housing units. Staff must have the relevant education and experience needed to implement supportive services.
