The purpose of this program is to establish a bonus program through which eligible city employees receive a one-time <u>bonus</u> of \$600 in appreciation for their dedication and service in 2022, when staffing shortages continued to impact departments and agencies across the city, often at the expense of the city workforce. The source of funding for this program is year-end vacancy savings that have occurred as a result of very vacancies that employees have been covering for. There is a companion bill to arrange funding for the general fund.
