Title: A resolution approving a proposed Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Stone Soup, Inc. to buy food from farmers, ranchers and distributors, with Denver Public School staff and social workers delivering the food to Denver Public School food pantries. Amends a grant agreement with Stone Soup, Inc., doing business as Stigma, by adding \$481,500 for a new total of \$901,145 and one year for a new end date of 7-31-2023, through funding from the Healthy Food for Denver’s Kids Initiative, to buy food from farmers, ranchers and distributors, with Denver Public School staff and social workers delivering the food to pantries at multiple locations in Council Districts 2, 6, 9, and 10 (ENVHL- 202159270-00/ ENVHL-202264167).
