

A bill for an ordinance establishing a new fund in the Public Health Special Revenue Fund for the "Public Health and Wellness Fund".

Establishes the Public Health and Wellness Special Revenue Fund to hold state public health dollars and general fund transfers for public health-related programs including opioid treatment programs. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 11-7-17.
