The artists were chosen through an open competitive process led by consultant, Barbara Neal, with participation from several residents and community members, the Central Park Public Art Advisory Committee, Denver Arts & Venues, Denver Parks & Recreation, Denver Department of Transportation & Infrastructure, Civitas Landscape Architects, Brookfield Properties, Denver Urban Renewal Authority, and the Central Park Master Community Association.
