At the time of conveyance of the District Parcels by the City to the Metropolitan Football Stadium District, the City imposed certain "football only" use restrictions on the District Parcels which are inconsistent with development of the property by DHA. Execution and recordation of Partial Release of Use Restriction and Right of Entry by the City and a Use Restriction and Reentry Covenant by MFSD will lift the restrictive condition from Parcels A and B that DHA is acquiring and transfer them to Parcel C that MFSD is acquiring.
