Type and Scope of services to be performed: This is a Grant IGA with Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) to provide funding for Preliminary and Final Design, Environmental Clearance (CatEx), ROW and Utility Clearances including Construction of an underpass for the High Line Canal at Mississippi and S. Parker Road located in the City and County of Denver (West & South) and Arapahoe County (North & East). The underpass is 14-foot wide, containing a 10-foot tall box culvert, approximately 160 feet in length, located north of the high line canal and north of the existing trail along the canal.
