United qualifies for an air service incentive because they are initiating new scheduled international air service at Denver International Airport (DEN) to Frankfurt. The incentive provides a maximum of \$2,500,000.00 in funds available for credits against operational expenses provided to United. United will receive a credit of \$30.00 per enplaned passenger during the first 12 months of operation of the new Denver-Frankfurt service. These credits will be approved by DEN before they are executed.
