Title: A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the Denver Urban Renewal Authority to assist the Department of Public Health and Environment with the administration of the Lead Based paint Hazard Control Grant Program. Approves a three-year \$2,608,211 intergovernmental agreement with Denver Urban Renewal Authority to administer the Lead Based Paint Hazard Control program (LBPHC) to mitigate lead paint hazards in low-income homes built before 1978 (ENVHL - 201843088-00). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 8-13-18. The Committee approved filing this item at its meeting on 7-11-18.
