Increasing the total cost of SC-00005781 from \$300,000 to \$700,000. The master purchase order is for the residential kitchen scrap containers. When the Master Purchase Order was initially issued, composting was an optional program for City residences.

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Since the issuance of the Master Purchase Order, DOTI has implemented the Pay as You Throw Program, which includes composting and the need for the number of containers has increased.
