**Title:** A bill for an ordinance making a rescission from and an appropriation in the Environmental Services Enterprise Fund, transferring cash to the Planned Fleet Special Revenue Fund, and authorizing a capital equipment purchase from the Planned Fleet Special Revenue Fund. Approves a rescission of \$900,000 from the Department of Public Health and Environment's Environmental Services Enterprise Fund, makes an appropriation, transferring cash to the Department of Public Works Planned Fleet Special Revenue Fund, and authorizes the purchase of capital equipment to support the City's composting program.
