This proposed amendment to Denver Revised Municipal Code, Chapter 27 is part of a regulatory package that also includes an amendment to the Denver Zoning Code and official map amendment for the 38th and Blake station area (under separate ordinance requests) to implement the recommendations of the Expanding Housing Affordability project. The proposed amendments to the Denver Revised Municipal Code include:

- updates the linkage fee definitions and provisions in Article V;
- repeals incentives for affordable housing Article VI; and

- establishes new provisions for mandatory affordable housing requirements and incentives in Article X.
