Title: A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Cable Franchise Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Comcast, for a non-exclusive cable television franchise, establishing new terms and conditions for high-definition channels, video-on-demand, free service to the public schools, channels for public education and government use, enforcement and other related public benefits.

(GOVERNMENT AND FINANCE) Renews for ten years the contract with Comcast for a non-exclusive cable television franchise agreement, establishing new terms and conditions for that franchise, including provisions for high-definition channels; video-on-demand; free service to the public schools; channels for public educational and government use; enforcement; and other related public benefits, and specifying customer service standards and compliance with all city, state, and federal requirements referring to Comcast infrastructure in the public rights-of-way. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 1-27-14. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 12-19-13.
