Title: A resolution laying out, opening and establishing as part of the City street system parcels of land as: 1) West 12th Avenue, located near the intersection of West 12th Avenue and North Meade Street; 2) North Meade Street, located at the intersection of North Meade Street and West 12th Avenue; 3) West 12th Avenue, located at the intersection of West 12th Avenue and North Meade Street; 4) West 12th Avenue, located near the intersection of West 12th Avenue and North Meade Street; and 5) West 12th Avenue, located at the intersection of West 12th Avenue and North Newton Street. Dedicates five parcels of land as Public Right-of-Way as 1) West 12th Avenue located near the intersection of West 12th Avenue and North Meade Street, 2) North Meade Street located at the intersection of North Meade Street and West 12th Avenue, 3) West 12th Avenue located at the intersection of West 12th Avenue and North Meade Street, 4) West 12th Avenue located near the intersection of West 12th Avenue and North Meade Street and 5) West 12th Avenue located at the intersection of West 12th Avenue and North Newton Street, in Council District 3.
