**Title:** A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Adams County to provide employment, education and training services under the second phase of the TEC-P program.  
Approves an intergovernmental agreement with Adams County for \$555,000 and through 1-31-25 for participation in the second phase of federally funded Technology Employment in Colorado Partnership (TEC-P), which will provide career counseling, and upskilling opportunities, and job placement for adult jobseekers, and for which DEDO will serve as grant administrator for Denver and its regional partners (OEDEV-202158069-00). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 6-7-21. The Committee approved filing this item at its meeting on 5-5-21.
