Title: A resolution laying out, opening and establishing as part of the City street system parcels of land as:
 1) East Arkansas Avenue, located at the intersection of South Colorado Boulevard and East Arkansas Avenue; 2) East Arkansas Avenue, located near the intersection of South Colorado Boulevard and East Arkansas Avenue; 3) East Arkansas Avenue, located at the intersection of South Ash Street and East Arkansas Avenue; and 4) East Arkansas Avenue, located at the intersection of East Arkansas Avenue and South Ash Street.
 Dedicates four parcels of land as public right-of-way, 1) East Arkansas Avenue, located at the intersection of South Colorado Boulevard and East Arkansas Avenue, 2) East Arkansas Avenue, located near the intersection of South Colorado Boulevard and East Arkansas Avenue, 3) East Arkansas Avenue, located at the intersection of South Ash Street and East Arkansas Avenue, and 4) East Arkansas Avenue located at the intersection of South Ash Street and East Arkansas Avenue, in Council District 6. The Committee approved filing this item at its meeting on 6-20-2023.
