**Title:** A bill approving and providing for the execution of a proposed grant agreement between the City and County of Denver and the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment concerning the "Public Health Emergency Preparedness" program and the funding therefor. Approves an intergovernmental agreement with the Colorado State Department of Public Health and Environment to accept the Public Health Emergency Preparedness Program grant award for \$575,717 and through 06-30-25 to improve medical and public health care preparedness and response capabilities, citywide (ENVHL-202473629). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 6-24-2024. The Committee approved filing this item at its meeting on 5-29-2024.
