**A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Fourth Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Denver Health and Hospital Authority, to provide harm reduction and treatment services to persons with opioid, methamphetamine and alcohol use disorders.**

Amends an intergovernmental agreement with Denver Health and Hospital Authority (DHHA) by adding \$264,000 for a new total of \$973,738 and one year for a new end date of 6-30-22 to increase outreach, harm reduction and treatment support for persons with opioid, methamphetamine and alcohol use disorders (ENVHL-202159324-04). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 9-20-21. The Committee approved filing this item at its meeting on 7-21-21.

**Type and Scope of services to be performed:**

This contract amendment is a sub-award of the revenue contract from the Colorado Department of Human Services (CDHS) in response to the Co-Responder Services Grant program. The City and County of Denver received funding 2018-2022 from CDHS to operate the Substance Use Navigator (SUN) program.

To carry out program objectives, DDPHE seeks to amend an existing contract with Denver Health and Hospital Authority (DHHA) for substance use navigation services to increase outreach, harm reduction and treatment support for persons with opioid, methamphetamine and alcohol use disorders. The contracted services include employment of two full-time Substance Use Navigators, one part-time Peer Specialist, the cost of an average of one bed per month, as available, for transitional residential substance use treatment (TRT), and the administration, supervision, support and related expenses for these services.
