Title: A bill for an ordinance approving and providing for the execution of a proposed Intergovernmental Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the State of Colorado, Department of Transportation, concerning the "Federal Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) 2018 Package 2 City and County of Denver Traffic Signal Replacement " project and the funding therefor. Accepts a grant from the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) for \$3.4 million and for five years, as part of the Federal Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) Package II to fund the construction of five new traffic signals located at the intersections of Federal Boulevard and 38th Avenue, Federal Boulevard and Kentucky Avenue, Federal Boulevard and Mississippi Avenue, Federal Boulevard and Jewell Avenue, and Colorado Boulevard and Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard in Council Districts 3 and 9 (201738522). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 1-22-18. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 12-19-17.
