Title: A resolution approving and providing for the execution of a proposed Grant Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the United States of America concerning the “FY19 Prosecuting Cold Cases Using DNA and Other Forensic Technologies” program and the funding therefor. Approves a grant agreement with the U.S. Department of Justice Office of Justice Programs National Institute of Justice for \$500,000 and through 12-31-22 for the FY 2019 program Prosecuting Cold Cases using DNA and Other Forensic Technologies, to increase the number of violent crime cold case prosecutions and decrease the number of unresolved violent crime cold cases awaiting prosecution (POLIC-201952269). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 2-3-20. The Committee approved filing this item at its meeting on 10-23-19.
