Title: A bill for an ordinance exempting the Career Service Board from conducting or obtaining an annual pay survey for the purpose of recommending market adjustments to pay ranges and pay rates to City Council on or before May 1, 2021, and maintaining the current classification and pay plan for employees in the Career Service and for certain employees not in the Career Service without market adjustments.

Approves the exemption of the Career Service Board from conducting the Annual Pay Survey and to maintain the current classification and pay plan for employees in the Career Service and for certain employees not in the Career Service without such market adjustments due to the extraordinary economic impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic crisis. The Committee approved filing this item at its meeting on 3-9-21.
