**A bill for an ordinance designating certain properties as being required for public use and authorizing use and acquisition thereof by negotiation, purchase and/or through condemnation proceedings of fee simple, easements and other interests, including any rights and interest related or appurtenant to such properties so designated, as needed for the traffic and pedestrian safety improvement project at various intersections on Colorado Boulevard between Mexico and Virginia and at the intersections of 13<sup>th</sup> and Lincoln and 8<sup>th</sup> and Speer.**

Grants the authority to acquire through negotiated purchase or condemnation, any property interest as needed for the traffic and pedestrian safety improvement project at various intersections on Colorado Boulevard between Mexico Avenue and Virginia Avenue and at the intersections of 13<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Lincoln Street and 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Speer Boulevard including easement interests, access rights, improvements, buildings, fixtures, licenses, permits and other appurtenances in Council districts 3, 6, and 10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 9-19-17.

The Project will improve the safety for vehicles and pedestrians at multiple intersections.
