<b>Title:</b>	<p>A resolution approving a proposed Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the Mental Health Center of Denver to co-manage the Denver Crisis Intervention Response Unit. Approves a contract with Mental Health Center of Denver for \$1 million and through 12-31-19 to co-manage the Denver Co-Responder program with the Denver Police Department and other city criminal justice agencies to improve outcomes, streamline services and create system efficiencies for persons with behavioral health issues who engage with members of Denver law enforcement, corrections, and emergency responders, citywide (201845517). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 1-7-19. The Committee approved filing this item at its meeting on 11-7-18.</p>
