**Title:** A bill for an ordinance authorizing cash transfers from the Capital Improvement Fund to the Human Services Special Revenue Fund and the Economic Opportunity Special Revenue Fund. Transfers \$9,950,000 in cash from the Capital Improvements Fund received from the sale of 1701 S. Platte Street, allocates \$3,200,000 to the DHS Homeless Services Fund and \$6,750,000 to the Affordable Housing Property Tax and Other Local Revenue Fund. The Committee approved filing this item at its meeting on 9-10-19.
