Type and Scope of services to be performed:

This amendment creates a \$2,000,000 contract between the Department of Housing Stability (HOST) and Northeast Denver Housing Center, Inc. (NDHC) to administer the Temporary Rental and Utility Assistance (TRUA) Program. This contract adds \$1,000,000 to the existing 2019 contract amount of \$1,000,000 and extends the contract through December 31, 2020.

NDHC will provide housing rental assistance and utility assistance to eligible households in the City and County of Denver. The program is designed to mitigate displacement by assisting lowand moderate-income residents experiencing a housing crisis maintain stability. TRUA can provide up to six months of rental assistance and/or up to two payments of utility assistance in a 24-month period to Denver households earning up to 80% of the area median income.

This \$2,000,000 contract is expected to serve approximately 960 unduplicated households with over 1200 rental assistance payments and over 150 utility assistance payments by December 31, 2020.
