Since then, they have transformed one of Denver's most economically marginalized neighborhoods, Westwood, into a thriving, resilient community. Building on the momentum of year 2, Re:Vision seeks to continue creating a local food system by involving local children in growing their own food, cooking classes, and education around food systems and food justice. Re:Vision programs are centered around culturally relevant food and content. Using the garden as a place for discovery and igniting a passion about Latino culture and history through the lens of healthy food.

- Promotoras will teach cooking classes in community settings at RISE Westwood, community centers, libraries, schools, and childcare centers.
