**Title:** A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Fifth Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Jefferson County Public Health, for collaborative assistance to continue building food systems and neighborhood environments as part of the Food In Communities (FIC) program.

Amends an intergovernmental agreement with Jefferson County Public Health by adding \$198,000 for a new total \$962,653.64 and one year for a new end date of 06-30-2023 to continue building collaborative food systems and neighborhood environments to increase equitable access to healthy, affordable foods as part of the Food in Communities (FIC) program, citywide (ENVHL-201842560/ ENVH-202264717). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 12-19-2022. The Committee approved filing this item at its meeting on 9-21-2022.
