**Title:** A resolution approving a proposed Amendatory Agreement between the City and County of Denver

and Aptim Environmental & Infrastructure, LLC to continue providing rebate administration services and funding to incentivize the adoption of highly efficient, all-electric energy equipment, electric modes of transportation, distributed energy resources such as solar photovoltaics and battery storage, and

other climate action technologies.

Amends a contract with Aptim Environmental & Infrastructure, LLC by adding \$18,000,000 for a new total of \$27,000,000 to continue providing rebate administration services and funding to incentivize the adoption of highly efficient, all-electric energy equipment, electric modes of transportation, distributed

energy resources such as solar photovoltaics and battery storage, and other climate action technologies (CASR-202261885-01/ CASR-202265206-01). The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 12-19-2022. The Committee approved filing this item at

its meeting on 11-16-2022.
