#### **Executive Summary with Rationale and Impact:**

To accept partial Formula & Minority AIDS Initiative (MAI) Ryan White HIV/AIDS Treatment Extension Act of 2009 Part A funds for the Denver Metropolitan Area in the amount of \$3,691,985.00 from the Health Resources & Services Administration (HRSA) for the period of March 1, 2017 - February 28, 2018 to provide services to persons living with HIV/AIDS in the Denver Metropolitan Area. Once the federal funder (HRSA) determines its final 2017 budget, the remainder of the funds will be disbursed. This is the 24<sup>th</sup> year the Department of Environmental Health, Denver Office of HIV Resources (DOHR) has received Ryan White Part A funding from the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services through the Health Resources & Services Administration. The Ryan White Part A funds enables the Denver Office of HIV Resources to conduct its work in procuring services for people living with HIV/AIDS, as well as cover administrative and oversight costs to run the program. The program is entirely funded with federal dollars.
